Understanding your Residential Electricity Bill



The price for electricity changed on May 1st 2011

Regulated Price Plan (RPP)

If you have a contract with an Electricity Retailer

Electricity Charge - RPP

The cost of electricity supplied to you during a billing period.

The Regulated Price Plan (RPP) rates are set by the Ontario Energy Board.

Tier 1 6.8 cents/kWh for 1st 600 kWh/mth

Tier 2 7.9 cents/kWh for usage above 600 kWh/mth

Electricity Charge - Time-of-Use

Starting June 1st the Regulated Price Plan tiered pricing will be changing to Time-of-Use pricing. See other side for Time-of-Use schedule.

The Regulated Price Plan (RPP) Time-of-Use rates are set by the Ontario Energy Board.

Off-peak 5.9 cents/kWh Mid-peak 8.9 cents/kWh

Delivery Charges

The cost to deliver the electricity from generating stations across provincial transmission lines and through Halton Hills Hydro's distribution system to your home. Rates are requested by Halton Hills Hydro and Hydro One and approved by the Ontario Energy Board.

Regulatory Charges

The cost of administering the wholesale electricity system, maintaining the reliability of the provincial grid and conservation programs. Rates are set by the Independent Electricity System Operator.

Debt Retirement Charge

The cost of paying down the former Ontario Hydro debt. Rates are set by the Ontario Government.




Time-of-Use (TOU)

As part of the Ontario government's plan to create a culture of conservation, Time-of-Use pricing will begin on June 1st in Halton Hills. Time-of-Use rates will apply to the first bill where all of your energy use is on or after June 1st.

TOU prices are based on the time of the day and day of the week when you use electricity. Prices are higher during periods of high demand (On-peak) and lower during periods of lower energy demand (Off-peak).

Below are the Time-of-Use time periods in effect across the province.
