### **NEW** Ontario Electricity Rebate

The new 31.8% Ontario Electricity Rebate takes effect November 1st, 2019. If you are a residential or small commercial customer, you automatically qualify and will see the rebate on bills with energy used after November 1st.

If your account is a multi-unit complex, long-term care facility or a farm, you are required to complete a new eligibility form, even if you had provided declaration under previous regulation.

## Changes to your electricity bill for electricity consumed on or after November 1, 2019

The Ontario Government has taken steps to make your electricity bill more transparent. Starting November 1, 2019, the Electricity Charge line reflects the true cost of electricity and most residential consumers, farmers and many small businesses will receive the new Ontario Electricity Rebate. The Ontario Electricity Rebate of 31.8% offsets most of the change in electricity prices and replaces the former 8% rebate.

Previously, residential, farm and most small business consumers received a reduction on their bill that was built into the price of electricity. The new Ontario Electricity Rebate replaces the previous built-in reduction and the former 8% rebate. This change allows you to see the true cost of electricity on your bill and the full value of your Ontario Electricity Rebate if you are eligible. If you also receive the Ontario Electricity Support Program, you will also see a new line that summarizes the Total Ontario Support on your bill.

The Ontario Electricity Rebate of 31.8% is for households, farms, long-term care homes and many small businesses. If you are a residential or small commercial customer, you do not need to do anything. You will automatically see the rebate for electricity consumed on or after November 1, 2019. If your account is for a farm, long-term care home or multi-unit complex, you need to complete a new self-declaration form and submit it to our office.
