#### **Understanding the Charges on Your Bill**

Your electricity bill contains 4 main categories:

**Electricity:** This is the price you pay for the energy that you use. **Delivery:** This section includes the costs to deliver the electricity from the generating stations to your home or business. This section includes Halton Hills Hydro's portion of the bill.

**Regulatory:** These are the costs associated with administering the wholesale electricity market.

**HST:** Electricity charges are subject to the Harmonized Sales Tax of 13%.

The graph to the right shows the typical residential electricity bill.
